### **2023 CONTEST CATEGORIES**

**PROFESSIONAL** 18 years years & older Entry by an individual or team.

**AMATEUR** 18 years of age & older Entry by an individual or team.

**TEEN** 13-17 years of age Entry by an individual or team.

**YOUTH** 9-12 years of age Entry by an individual or team.

**CHILD** 6-8 years of age Entry by an individual or team.

**PINT SIZE DIVISION** 5 years of age & under Entry by an individual or team.

### **Q** JUDGING

Entries will be judged on a scale of 1-5 based on:

- · Overall Appearance
- Originality
- · Use of Materials
- Consistency of Theme

The "People's Choice Award" will be awarded based on public voting.

Winners will be announced at the Awards Ceremony on Sunday, December 10, 4-5 pm

### **✓ ENTRY DROP OFF**

Completed entries must be delivered to Crystal Coast Civic Center on Friday, December 8, between the hours of 10 am and 2 pm. The Gingerbread Festival Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry deemed inappropriate which does not follow the rules and guidelines. Any entry which begins to look in disrepair may be removed from display.

### **ENTRY SPECIFICS**

Entries are not limited to the structure of a house but must have been constructed in 2023. There is no overall theme for the competition. Competitors are encouraged to uniquely design their entry.

### MATERIAL & CONSTRUCTION

The main structure should be constructed 100% of gingerbread, some of which should be exposed. Everything above the base should be edible materials. The use of gingerbread house kits is allowed ONLY by entrants in the Youth (9-12) and Child (6-8) Categories. Entries in the **Pint Size Category** should be constructed using a milk carton and graham crackers.

**Everything visible on entries in ALL categories must be edible.** Candies must be unwrapped and free of any non-edible materials, for example, lollipop sticks. Two-dimensional fondant/marzipan/gum paste components cut with a smart cutting machine (Circuit, Silhouette, etc,) are permitted. No 3D printed components. No hot glue, icing only. No electric will be available for entries.

**Display Board Rules:** All entries should be submitted on a wooden or plastic base, no larger than 24"L x 18"W. Entries should not exceed 26" in height. Nonedible materials such as paint and/or ribbon are approved and encouraged to decorate the outer edge of your base only. The base is considered part of the judging criteria and should complement your creation.

### **7 ENTRY IDENTIFICATION**

Following receipt of the Competitor Entry form, entrant will receive a confirmation email providing the GBF number. Entries must be clearly labeled with its assigned GBF number. This can be incorporated into the piece or on the outer edge of the base.

### **Q** ENTRY DESCRIPTION SUMMARY

The Description Summary form will be emailed to you along with your assigned GBF number. The purpose of the summary is to better inform the judges of your vision, theme, process, and material usage that may not be obvious from viewing your entry. Summary should be anonymous and free from identifying factors.

### **O** ENTRY PICKUP

Entries may be taken after the Awards Ceremony on Sunday, December 10 or picked up on Monday, December 11 between 8:30 am -12 pm. Any entry not picked up by the specified time will be discarded.
